



Single stream recycling service

We're bringing Single-Stream Recycling to Valley Center. Use your green cart with the yellow lid to place all your recyclables together, no sorting needed! Place your cart at the curb no earlier than 5 p.m. on the day before collection. Retrieve your cart no later than 8 p.m. on the day of collection, or 2 hours after collection – whichever is later.

Like empty cereal and cracker boxes.

Trash service

Use the green cart with the green lid only for trash that cannot be recycled. Place your cart at the curb no earlier than 5 p.m. on the day before collection. Retrieve your cart no later than 8 p.m. on the day of collection, or 2 hours after collection – whichever is later.

Food or any organic waste

Polystyrene (Styrofoam)

Carbon paper

Liquids

Used paper cups and paper plates

Carpet and cloth

Plastic bags and clear plastic wrap

Used paper towels and tissues

Food-soiled cardboard

The City of Valley Center has selected Waste Management to be the single provider of trash and recycling services.

STARTING JANUARY 3, 2011

Dear Valley Center Resident:

Starting January 3, 2011, Waste Management will be providing the City of Valley Center with reliable trash collection and recycling services. We look forward to helping your community be as clean – and green – as possible throughout the new year and beyond.

Making the transition from your current provider to Waste Management will be simple. Here are a few things to keep in mind:

New Carts

Each residence should have received two new 95-gallon carts, delivered December 13-17 of this year. Starting January 3, 2011, we will service only these new carts. Please use the green cart for trash only, and the green cart with the yellow lid for recyclables only. The weight limit for each cart is 200 pounds.

Old Carts

Please use your old cart for trash collection through December 27th. Then set that cart out at the curb the week of January 3rd and we'll collect it for you.

Bulk Items

Waste Management will collect one bulk item per week per household at no additional charge. If you have more than this, please call City Hall at 316-755-7310. (Additional fees will apply.) Place your bulk item at the curb on the same day as your regular trash collection. Items must be smaller than seven feet and weigh less than 75 pounds.

What is a bulk item? It's an appliance, piece of furniture, or some other residential item that's too large for a container. Construction debris and hazardous waste are not allowed as bulk items.

Bulk Waste

- Smaller than 7 feet, lighter than 75 pounds
- Couches, chairs, household furniture
- Carpeting (cut into 4-foot bundles)
- Large yard waste, such as tree limbs
- Bicycles

NOT Bulk Waste

- Larger than 7 feet, heavier than 75 pounds
- Construction and demolition debris
- Concrete, brick, asphalt, roofing
- Vehicles and parts

Hazardous Items

Waste Management will not collect solid or liquid hazardous waste. Examples include; paint, pesticides, petroleum derivatives, such as motor oil and solvents, and explosive items.


