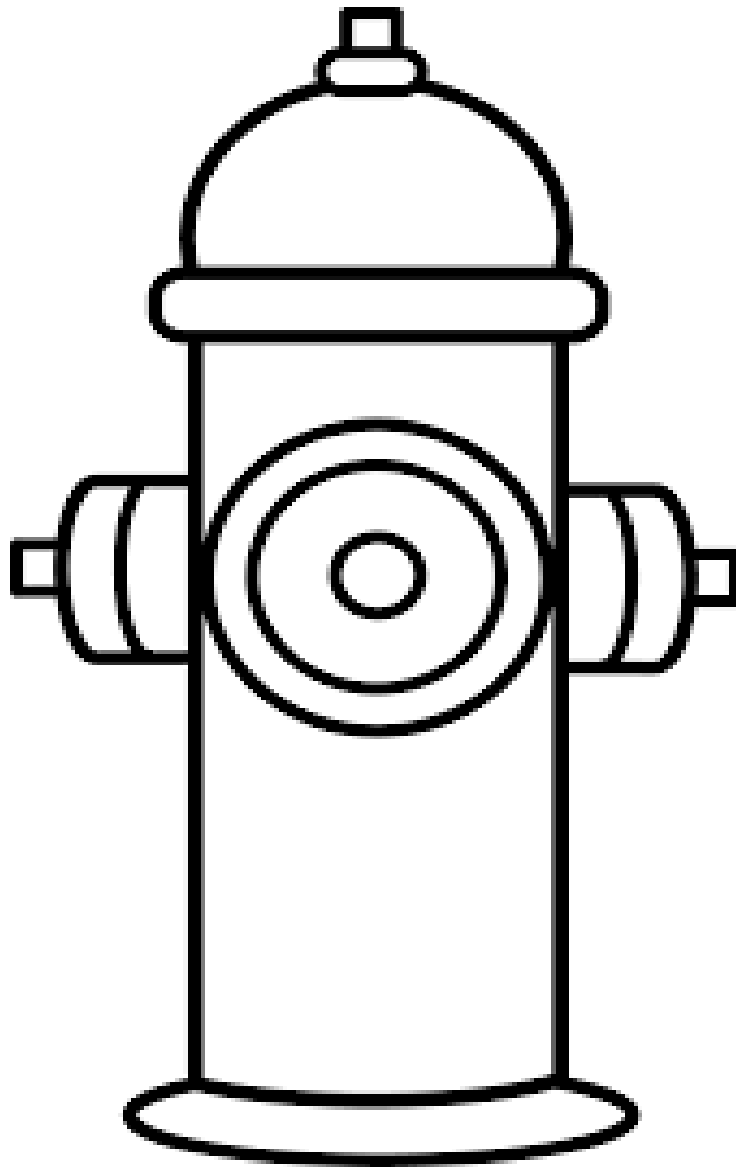

# Vibrant Hydrant Program

## PAINT INSTRUCTIONS

- Select a day to paint your hydrant that's sunny and not raining.
- The outside temperature needs to be at least 50 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Ensure that the hydrant is dry and free from dirt or other contaminants by using a rag to wipe off any moisture and dirt.
- Lightly brush off any loose or chipping paint on the hydrant with the wire brushes provided.
- DO NOT remove fire hydrant caps to paint as to not get paint on the threads.
- If your hydrant is near cement, take care to not get paint on the cement by placing down a tarp.
- The preferred paint is an enamel paint that is designed for metal surfaces, these can be purchased at most any hardware stores that sells paint. However the colors may be limited in this type of paint. A durable exterior latex paint can also be used if needed.
- Spray paint is also acceptable to use and may provides a wider variety of color to fit your theme.
