Animal Licensing Process Suspended



It has come to the attention of City staff that some residents are concerned about their inability to renew or get new licenses for their pets. During this time of crisis, Valley Center understands it is necessary for our citizens to prioritize activities in their daily lives. Although maintaining pet licenses is important, the City understands that there are more critical issues our citizens need to focus on.

The City is therefore suspending accepting new and renewal pet license applications until it is determined that the current crisis is at a point where all City services have been restored. No enforcement action will be taken for expired pet licenses during this timeframe. Residents will be notified in advance when these changes are no longer in place.

We encourage you to continue to maintain a current rabies vaccination on your pets and make sure you remember they need to be cared for just like all of the other family members.
