
Pros

- Existing Pool Can Remain Open During Construction

Cons

- Parcel Shape
- Emporia Street & Utility Improvements
- Parking Remote From Entrance
- Parking Issues w/ Soccer Users
- Eliminates Disc Golf
- Impact to Existing Pond
- Limited Expandability





Lions Park – Option 3









Answered: 1,179 Skipped: 14


